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- We support the inclusion of school aged pupils (**3-19**) with Autistic Spectrum Condition (ASC), Severe Learning Difficulties (SLD) or Profound & Multiple Learning Difficulties (PMLD) in mainstream settings.

- We are staffed by 4 Teachers, 1 Senior Teaching Assistant and a Developmental Psychologist who have experience and expertise in working with pupils with ASC/SLD/PMLD.



We currently have 229 pupils in our caseload


Primary schools*: 164 pupils

HOW WE WORK WITH YOUR CHILD (continued)

- The school will receive a report based on our discussions and observation
(You can ask the school for a copy of this report)
- The school will ensure that, if appropriate, other professionals working with your child (e.g. Speech & Language Therapist) receive a copy of the report
- We will monitor your child's progress and support will be on-going



HOW WE WORK WITH YOUR CHILD (continued)

- **The Bridge Outreach is a service to schools so unfortunately you cannot refer your child directly to us.** However, we will be happy to meet with you at annual review meetings or any appropriate meeting arranged by the school
