

Need:

the parent of a disabled child cannot get regular breaks as the child cannot access social or recreational activities without additional support at the setting to keep them and others safe

Outcome:

the parent of a disabled child gets a regular short break and so is better able to care for that child.

Provision:

156 hours of short breaks funding £1987.44 (156 hrs x £12.74)

Options:

- Support worker £10 per hour
- Summer scheme £100 per day (6 hours)
- Swimming lessons £25 per session 1/2 hour Travel to see grandma £200 for 5 day break Horse riding £50 per session 45 mins

Need: to support the family to get disabled child to school as they live 4 miles away and there are 3 other children at other schools.

Outcome: the children get to school

Options

Need: the single parent needs support to move and bathe a physically disabled child in the home, safely use the hoist and monitor their oxygen levels at night.

Outcome: the child's physical health needs are met safely

Options

Need: the child's mental health means that they are not able to attend a school for several months
