Why do we need this policy?



To make sure that everyone is treated fairly and not **discriminated** against because of who they are



Discriminate means treating someone another way because of something 'different' about them



Everyone who gets support from or who works for Centre 404 should be treated fairly and with no discrimination



The UK has a law called the Equality Act

It gives everyone the right to be treated fairly



Equality means

Everyone having equal rights and being treated fairly

Not everyone needs the same support but everyone's needs are just as important



Diversity means

We are all different from each other in different ways

No one is better or worse than anyone else and we respect everyone



Centre 404 values everyone's differences

It makes Centre 404 a more interesting place!



Centre 404 wants to be open and transparent

This means not hiding things like if something goes wrong



We will ask for feedback and ideas so we can find out

- what is important to you
- how we can do better

We will ask the people who work for us about this too



We talk about equality and diversity at Centre 404 in lots of different ways

- In meetings and our committees
- When we are advertising and interviewing people for jobs
- All staff get equality and diversity training
- Having policies like this one for staff and service users to read



It is against the law to discriminate against anyone because of these things



Marital or Civil Partnership status

If a person is single, married or in a civil partnership



Disability

If a person has a disability or impairment of any kind



Religion and beliefs

If a person has spiritual beliefs or if they do not have any



Sexual Orientation

If a person is a lesbian, gay or bi-sexual or any other LGBTQ+ orientation



Race and ethnicity

A person's skin colour or their family background



Age

How old or young a person is



Gender Reassignment

If a person has had or is going through a sex-change



Maternity or Pregnancy

If a person is pregnant or has just had a baby



Sex

If a person is a man or a woman



Centre 404 gives flexible support to people

We will find the best way to support you if your needs change



Centre 404 makes sure that everyone can use our services

Like getting in and out of our buildings or using equipment



We have user-friendly services for everyday living like a walk or wheel in shower



We will find the best way to communicate with you and everyone we support



We can give you information in an Easy Read design like this policy



We have an easy read Complaints Procedure

If anyone feels they have been treated unfairly they can make a complaint



We make sure everyone can join in the activities they want to do



We make sure no one is left out from taking part in activities or making choices about their support



We think about everyone's religions

We would not arrange an event or meeting on a special Holy day if that meant you could not join in



We will think about and respect your background and culture when we do assessments and write your person centred plan

We might do a separate cultural support plan for you



Our leaflets and pictures include people from different backgrounds



Everyone is free to choose

- the type of relationship they want
- to be who they want to be

On one else should judge them



No one should be harassed, bullied or victimised

We have rules about this in other policies about Bullying and Harassment



Centre 404 will not allow inappropriate behaviour towards our staff

We might decide to stop support and services if we cannot resolve the issues raised



We have clear and fair ways of finding staff and volunteers



We choose staff and volunteers because of the values and skills they have

Like being good listeners and being kind



We include service users in finding new staff when we can
